

TSPO2 Oven & Storage Bags

Cook food in the oven, store food chilled or frozen



Terinex **TSPO2** oven bags are available in a variety of sizes to meet the requirements of the consumer in over 40 countries.

LOOK bags are specially formulated to cook meat, fish and vegetables so that all the natural juices and flavours circulate in the bag. This means there is no need to baste, the food browns through the bag and there is no need to worry about a messy oven afterwards!

Cooking times will vary according to oven type, but you may find food cooks quicker using LOOK bags.

The bags are also suitable for microwave cooking, encouraging even and moist cooking.

Use LOOK bags to freeze, defrost and reheat plated meals.

Always thaw frozen meat or fish completely before cooking.

LOOK Oven bags recommended use up to 200°C (425°F) Gas Mark 6.

Bags are supplied in counter display boxes, each box containing 24 envelopes.

Easy to use instructions

CONVENTIONAL OVEN INSTRUCTIONS

- Preheat oven to required temperature – save energy, do not use above 180°C in fan assisted ovens.
- Season food and place in bag. Close with special tie leaving plenty of air inside to assist browning.
- Snip off top corner of bag to allow steam to escape
- Place in deep roasting dish and cook in centre of oven. Bags must not touch oven walls, racks or heating element.
- When cooked, cut bag open and remove food - use juices for making tasty gravy.

MICROWAVE OVEN INSTRUCTIONS

- Season food and place in bag. Close with special tie provided, leaving plenty of air inside to assist browning. **DO NOT USE METAL TIES.**
- Snip off top corner of bag to allow steam to escape
- Place in microwave dish and cook at the appropriate power level for required time.
- When cooked, cut bag open and remove food - use juices for making tasty gravy.
